Fact: Roof rats are incredibly good climbers and they are the ones that do the damage mainly within upper/higher areas of dwellings/buildings.

SIGNS TO LOOK OUT FOR:



SCRATCHING NOISES



RAT DROPPINGS



RUNNING TRACKS



SMELL



RUB MARKS



DAMAGE

WHAT WE DO:

Ask where they are being seen or heard. Look for visible signs.

Use secured bait. The rats are forced to eat the bait where it is.

Carry out inspections in roof voids, sub-floors and the surrounding perimeter of the building

RODENT CONTROL OPTIONS:

A preventative maintenance program. We set up bait and bait stations and service them.

A six week program where we set up the bait and bait stations, then re-bait them fortnightly.

DIY Rodent Control

Option One: purchase the products yourself

Option Two: You buy the bait and bait stations. We set them up, draw a site plan, and offer the tools and advice for the future.
